INVESTMENT AND GROWTH

Walking by Faith has collaborated with various ministries, both nationally and internationally, for many years—a commitment that will continue. Additionally, we are increasing our focus on local communities, providing meals to school children in need, helping the homeless with essential supplies, and offering companionship to the elderly, all while incorporating ministry into our efforts.

CHURCH EVENTS, CONFERENCES, AND MEETINGS

This year, we successfully hosted a variety of events and meetings—and enjoyed ourselves along the way! Our activities included a visit from a South African missionary, gatherings with local pastors, a Youth Conference themed "Shaping Your Future," the Happy Life Women's Conference, and our Church Anniversary—all of which will now become annual traditions. We also began weekly Zoom Women's Bible Studies and, most recently, launched a monthly Men's Fellowship.

INVESTING IN OUR CHILDREN

We have supported the orphanage in Kenya, Africa by securing farmland, enabling greater self-sufficiency in food supplies. This initiative has been highly successful. Two of the youth in that city, Moses and Marguerite financed their college education independently of ministry funds. Both have graduated. Praise the Lord! Now, a youth from the orphanage, Joshua, has recently entered college to pursue studies in the medical field. The children continue to require school fees, and the orphanage has recently admitted 10 new children, bringing the total number to 20!



EXPANDING OUR REACH WITH PODCASTING

The *Altar Moments With God* podcast, launched in May of this year, is designed for Christian women. It emphasizes the significance of remembering and reflecting on meaningful life experiences where commitments to God are established.
